INTRODUCTION :

The Telangana Chambers of Commerce and Industry is incorporated under section 25, sub section 1 and clause (a) of the Indian Companies Act 1956 after obtaining the License from the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India.

This organization was established after holding a series of discussions with various sections of the business and industrial community from all parts of the region. Some of the eminent professors, academicians and other administrators also took part in these deliberations and became a part of the decision making group.

The Group had reviewed the development of Trade, Commerce and Industry in Telangana region during the times of Nizam's rule, Hyderabad state and subsequently formed Andhra Pradesh state in the year 1956. After taking stock of the situation in all respects, it was decided to keep a more result-oriented, transparent and dedicated institution in place to take care of Trade, Commerce and Industry in Telangana area with much more concentration and attention.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS :

Any Firm, Individual, Partnership, Company, Corporation, Small Scale Industry or Association, engaged or interested in Trade, Commerce, Industry, Mining, Transport or other mercantile pursuits is eligible for election as an Associate Member of the TECCI. Such Member being liable to pay an annual subscription as may be fixed in respect of an Associate Member under Article -9.

COMPANY MEMBERS :

Any Company or corporation engaged in Trade, Commerce, Industry, Mining, Transport or other mercantile pursuits shall be eligible for election as a "Company Member".

AFFILIATE MEMBERS :

Any Association established for the purpose of promoting and protecting the interests of any section of Trade, Commerce, Industry or Finance, may be affiliated to the TECCI and be elected as an "Affiliate Member" provided that such an Association files its rules and its list of Members and the names of its office-bearers from time to time.

SSI MEMBERS :

A company or corporation or firm which is classified under SSI with a Certificate from the Department of Industry or under the Government definition as per Industrial Development and Regulation Act from time to time is eligible to be an SSI Member.

FIRM & INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS :

Any firm or partnership in Trade, Commerce, Industry, Mining, Transport or other mercantile pursuits shall be eligible for election as a "Firm Member".

Any individual engaged in Trade, Commerce, Industry, Mining, Transport or other mercantile pursuits but not associated with any firm or partnership or any Company or Corporation as Managing Partner or Managing Agent or Managing Director or as Secretary or Manager or Officer shall be entitled to be elected as an "Individual Member".

LIFE MEMBERS :

Individuals, Firms and Partnerships, Companies and Corporations and Associations who are eligible for election as Ordinary Members of the TECCI can be admitted as Life Members at the discretion of the Managing Committee and shall after admission, they are entitled to all the privileges of Ordinary Members during their life time. Life Members shall pay a sum equivalent to 10 times the rate of subscription in addition to the Admission Fee as applicable to all categories of Ordinary Members from time to time under Article 9.
